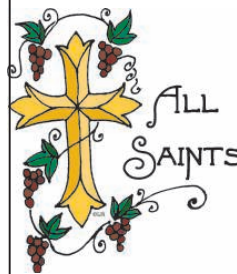

**ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEEDS YOUR HELP!**

The St. Gerald St. Vincent de Paul Conference provides aid to families living within our parish boundaries. This aid may be for food, rent, utilities, or other basic needs. We cannot do this without the generous support of our parish community. For this we are deeply grateful, especially to those who are regular donors.

Over the past 12 months we have made 122 home visits and been able to:

- Pay \$26,091 rental assistance.
- Pay \$5,469 utilities assistance.
- Obtain an additional \$4,256 utility assistance through MEAP (THAW funds).
- Provide \$4,280 in other assistance such as furniture and medical needs.
- Provide 232 bags of food.
- Provide \$985 in food and gas cards.

We also invite anyone interested in volunteering to assist in this ministry to call 248-476-7677 x-220 and leave a message. In addition to serving the needy, members of St. Vincent de Paul benefit from prayer and fellowship.

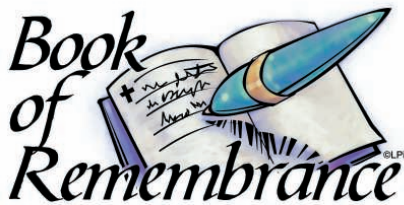

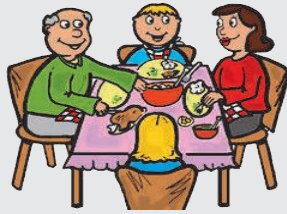

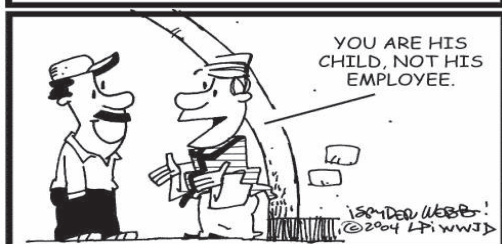
**SENEX ADULT DAY PROGRAM**
