



FATHER FESTUS MEDICAL MISSION UPDATE

Father Festus wants to share with everyone the success of his CORE Nigeria 2017 mission. More people than ever came to his medical mission for free treatment, medications and, because Nigeria is in a recession, just to receive food. Children received treatment for fever, malaria, coughs , asthma, etc. The adults were treated for diabetes, high blood pressure, asthma, arthritis and eye issues.

Father visited a government hospital where care is nearly non-existent and managed to relocate some patients to better hospitals. He also negotiated the release of 12 patients who were held against their will for non-payment of their hospital bills. He placed down-payments for others and, depending on how much money he has left, will try to gain their release.

One particularly sad case was an 11 year old boy who needed life-saving cancer surgery but the family had no money. Father managed to relocate him to a better hospital and arrange to pay the cost of the surgery and care. Father said, "The parents are thrilled and beyond themselves."

Father Festus stated, "Please pray that I can accomplish all I have proposed in this visit. I am truly thankful for all those who made this relief effort possible. May God reward every one of my supporters. Blessing to all."

KNIGHTS CORNER

By the time mass finished, the Knights had found and lit about 80 candles and moved trays of ham and sausage from the electric convection oven to the gas-fired oven. Pancake production was unaffected since it is done on a propane gas-fired griddle. A few minutes after the second serving began, parishioner Jon Esper arrived with a gasoline-fired generator and produced more light to supplement the candlepower.

"In spite of the power problems, we probably served the most people in the last five or six years," Event Manager Dave Bednarski said. "Thanks to all the St. Gerald folks for supporting this effort to help the parish Religious Education Technical Fund." Bednarski said a big "Atta Boy" is due the 24 Knights who produced the event. A big Thank You to Peter Baracco, Emma DuLong, Ryan Hulbert, Steven Ihm, Kevin Szwarc, Carlos Tello, Allison Thomson and Ben Webber from the St. Gerald Knights.

Although expense figures hadn't been tabulated at press time, Treasurer Rich Rosowski said the event produced a sizeable amount for the Religious Education program. Final figures will be available in next week's Knights Corner, he said.
