


ST. GERALD WOMEN'S GROUP

Last Month's Pancake Breakfast Benefit Netted \$1,290 for Religious Ed Tech Fund

Although a power failure had the second shift of diners at the Jan. 22 Pancake Breakfast eating in a dimly candle-lit hall, net proceeds were very, very bright. Treasurer Rich Rosowski will report at Tuesday's Officers' Meeting that the breakfast cleared \$1,290 for the parish Religious Education Technical Fund.

That amount was made up of donations of \$520, \$129 representing the Knights share of the 50/50 drawing and \$977 in ticket sales less expenses. Religious Education Director Mary Taylor was overjoyed with the results, adding the money will be used to upgrade and add badly needed audio visual equipment and materials.

Other items on the agenda for Council Officers when they meet Tuesday, Feb. 7, will include a discussion of a proposed membership drive later this month and how the Knights will cook for the Feb. 28 Shrove Tuesday Pancake Dinner. The dinner is a project of the Christian Service Commission.

With dinner service starting at 5 PM, Knights will have to be in the kitchen by 4 PM. If you are free that afternoon, give Program Director Tom McPhail a call at 248-875-1185 or an e-mail at tandamcphail@att.net. Christian Service volunteers will be handling the other duties — setup, food line, serving, dish washing and cleanup.

A big welcome to Ron Bywalec, who transferred into our Council after 30 years of membership in St. Francis Council, which is now located at Our Lady of Sorrows Church. Ron and his wife Linda are long-time St. Gerald parishioners. As a transferee, Ron does not count toward our 2016-17 membership requirement.


