

TIM'S TIDBITS

We begin the Fifth Week of Lent. Our second reading today, invites us to live in Christ. We must live in the spirit of Christ. It is by believing and through baptism that we receive this Spirit who dwells within us and gives us new Life.

Next week is Palm Sunday our Liturgies that weekend will tend to be a bit longer, as we have the blessing of palm branches and processions.



At the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, we wash the feet of volunteers from our parish community. If anyone would like to have their feet washed at the evening Mass, please let me know.

On Good Friday, we will have stations that the Confirmation students will enact at 12:30 PM. At 1:15 PM the Good Friday Service will begin. This is a service with three parts; the Liturgy of the Word, the Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. We will venerate one cross, like we did last year, the cross that is draped in the gathering space. Around 5:00 PM, you are welcome to come and help decorate the church for Easter.

On Holy Saturday morning, we have the egg hunt, butter lamb and basket blessings. In the evening at 8:30 PM is the Great Easter Vigil. If you have never been to the Easter Vigil, I hope you would consider coming. This year, we will have one adult confirmation. It is a beautiful Liturgy and the high point of the Church Year. Have a prayerful week.


