

HANDS AND FEET OF JESUS

Over the last several months our St. Vincent de Paul Conference has been able to help numerous clients. Thanks to MEAP (Michigan Energy Assistance Program) funding, we have been able to help clients with their electric and gas bills. Since October 1, 2016, we have applied for and received approximately \$9,240.00 in MEAP funding to help those in need to keep their electric and gas services.

In the month of March, our conference helped 14 clients. We provided seven bags of food and issued \$70.00 in food cards. We also helped seven people (some of the same people to whom we gave food) remain in their residence by paying their rent. Those rent payments totaled \$2,862.44. On behalf of our clients, thank you for your continued generosity and prayers.


