



TIM'S TIDBITS

Living the Paschal Mystery

Pentecost is more than celebrating the "birthday" of the church - it celebrates our "birth" into risen Life ("he breathed on them"; cf. Gen 2:7) and being sent forth armed with peace to forgive others. We can speak of a "birthday" of the church (the church being the Body of Christ) only when we make the church a reality through forgiveness of one another. Then every day is a "birthday" – a birthing of the risen Life of Christ in each other. Forgiveness is the church's CPR.

Forgiveness is sometimes the most difficult thing we do; so many simple acts in our everyday living demand that we seek and give forgiveness. This is why Jesus sent the Spirit: to empower us, through the common risen Life we share, to forgive, to heal divisions in the community, to be peacemakers. We overcome our fears and unlock the doors on our closed relationships when we reach out to others in forgiveness.



Father Patrick Collins will be visiting our parish next weekend to speak at all the Masses on behalf of Cross Catholic Outreach, which was

founded to create a meaningful link between parishes and America and the priests and nuns working in the church overseas in the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Central and South America.

Father Collins is an outstanding preacher, author, musician and university professor. Born in Peoria, Illinois, he was ordained to Ministerial Priesthood on May 31, 1964. He has served as a priest with the Archdiocese of Chicago from 1993 to 2002 teaching, writing, preaching retreats and





doing parish missions. He has lectured at the University of Notre Dame, University of California, Catholic Theological Union, St. Michael's College, VT and St. Meinrad Seminary, IN.

He obtained a Ph.D. from Fordham University in 1972 and a Masters from St. Paul Seminary in 1963. An accomplished musician, he read for a Bachelor of Music at University of Illinois in 1959 and studied choral conducting with Robert Shaw, Princeton, NJ. His writings and recordings explore Historical Theology and U.S. culture in the light of the Judaeo-Christian tradition.

Fr. Collins's commitment to social justice is expressed in his dedication to Cross Catholic Outreach as he joins with us to help the poorest of the poor in the developing world.
