



Knights Urged to Take Free CPR/AED Training in Case Emergency Life Saving Skills Needed

You can be a lifesaver. Not the candy kind, but the kind that comes to the aid of a fellow Mass goer who collapses with a heart attack. With the proper training you would use one of the two Automated External Defibrillaters (AED) in the church to effect the rescue. But first you must be trained.

A four hour Heartsaver CPR/AED training class will be taught this Wednesday beginning at 6 PM by Barbara Seabolt, chair of the Parish Health Ministry and wife of brother Knight Thom Seabolt. The class is free and will be conducted in the Social Hall. To register for the class, sign up at the Health Ministry table in the Social Hall or call the Parish Office.

Mrs. Seabolt also is teaching another class of interest to Knights and spouses, a basic first aid class. Also free and conducted in the Social Hall, it will be held at 6 PM, June 28.

At the June 20 Membership Meeting, members will be selecting a Family of the Year from among the Knight families who were chosen by the leadership for Family of the Month honors. 
