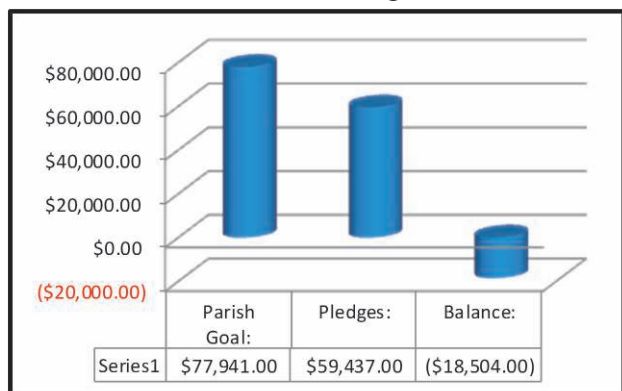
**CSA - Natural Family Planning**

- Believing with the Church community
- Living with the Church community
- Praying with the Church community
- Serving with the Church community

The RCIA is intended to serve:

- The unbaptized who would like to learn more about the Catholic religion.
- Those baptized in another religion who think they might like to become Catholic.
- Those baptized Catholics who have not completed the Initiation Sacraments.

The RCIA Process is much more than a program:

- It is a learning and loving process in which conversion of the heart brings one to Christ in a powerful manner.
- It is an answer to the Gospel invitation "Come to me all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart. Your soul will find rest, for my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

South Oakland Shelter (SOS) provides homelessness prevention, sustainable housing and career development strategies and programs for homeless and at-risk people seeking stabilization and self-sufficiency.

We are hosting the shelter at North Congregational Church with them and the Muslim Community Mosque the week of August 20th. Combined, we will provide transportation, meals, housing, entertainment and hospitality for 30 to 35 clients for a week from Sunday evening through the following Sunday morning. Guests spend their days at work or at SOS – in training and counseling - in Lathrup Village before returning to North Congregational in time for dinner. 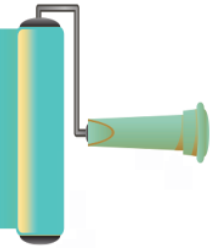
