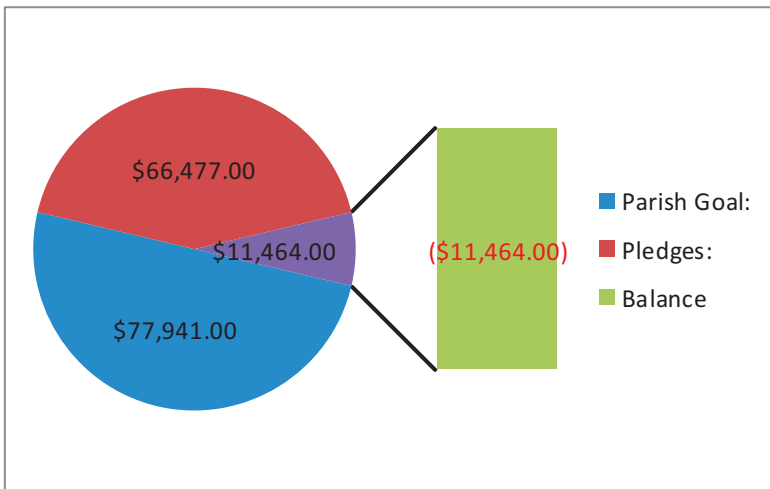

The RCIA is intended to serve:

- The unbaptized who would like to learn more about the Catholic religion.
- Those baptized in another religion who think they might like to become Catholic.
- Those baptized Catholics who have not completed the Initiation Sacraments.

The RCIA Process is much more than a program:

- It is a learning and loving process in which conversion of the heart brings one to Christ in a powerful manner.
- It is an answer to the Gospel invitation "Come to me all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart. Your soul will find rest, for my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

The Capuchin Franciscan Order of St. Joseph in Detroit has announced that the date for the Father Solanus Casey beatification ceremony will be Saturday, November 18, 2017 at Ford Field in Detroit. This follows the historic announcement by Pope Francis on May 4 that Father Solanus Casey will be elevated to Blessed in the Roman Catholic Church. Details on the Fr. 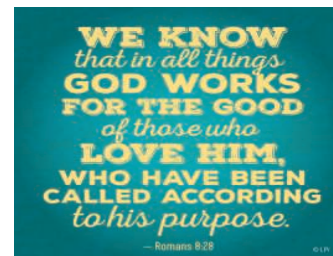

**KNIGHTS CORNER**

*State of Michigan Millionaire Party License Approved But How Do We Make Use of It?*

Now that the State of Michigan has approved our Millionaires Party License, how we use it is the next question to be answered. And that will be one of the items on the agenda when the Officers hold their regular monthly meeting this coming Tuesday, August 1. That question, also, will be pursued by the committee of Thom Seabolt, Chancellor Frank Gariepy and Bruce Berend who, with Treasurer Rich Rosowski, put together the license application.

As promised, July’s Membership Meeting was a short one – 28 minutes – according to the clock watchers. That allowed members time for fellowship that included corn on the cob and hot dogs. A big “Atta Boy” to our cooking crew of Project Leader Ken May, Arnie Lemieux, Patrick McDonald and Bill Croitori.

Although it was a fast meeting a couple of key decisions were made. One was the approval of the 2017-18 Council budget as presented by Treasurer Rosowski. The other was an OK for the Council to again participate with other Councils in underwriting a regional billboard campaign carrying the message of “Keep Christ in Christmas, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus.” An expenditure of \$55, as our share of the project was approved. Brian Gulick is leading the “Keep Christ in Christmas” campaign for our Council.

The shrinking dollar has caught up with the State K of C’s Take Five Program, used at dues paying time to supplement the State’s charitable giving. Earlier this year, the program raised nearly \$109,000, a tidy sum. However, while the need has increased since the program started in 1977, the value of the dollar has shrunk in the 40 years since. With your 2018 calendar year dues statement, you will be asked to participate in “\$10 for Charity.” That money goes directly to the State K of C. The State K of C has also unveiled a new rewards program to encourage individual Knights to recruit new members. For every member you propose in August and September, you will receive a \$5 gift card and be entered in a drawing for one of ten \$50 gift cards. In October, if you propose five members or reactivated members you will receive a K of C pen and pencil set. To propose a member you use a Form 100, which are available on the Knights table in the corner of the Social Hall. After having the prospective member complete and sign the form, you also should sign as the proposer and enter your membership number listed on your membership card. Give the completed Form 100 to any officer.

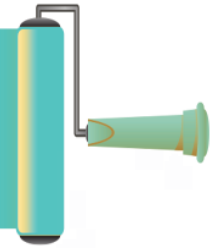
