



- The unbaptized who would like to learn more about the Catholic religion.
- Those baptized in another religion who think they might like to become Catholic.
- Those baptized Catholics who have not completed the Initiation Sacraments.

The RCIA Process is much more than a program:

- It is a learning and loving process in which conversion of the heart brings one to Christ in a powerful manner.
- It is an answer to the Gospel invitation "Come to me all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart. Your soul will find rest, for my yoke is easy and my burden is light."



Your Officers will be meeting Tuesday, September 5 with one of the main discussion points being what will we do with the net proceeds from the September 24 pancake breakfast. Although our parish St. Vincent de Paul Conference will benefit from a special collection at this weekend's masses, the need is very great.

In the past 12 months, SVDP has made 139 home visits, paid out more than \$33,670 in rental and utility assistance, obtained \$12,747 in MEAP and THAW help and distributed \$1,055 worth of food and gas cards and 227 bags of food. The recipients of this help all live within our parish boundaries.

Officers also will be discussing the Installation of Officers' Ceremony, which will replace the September 19 Membership Meeting. The Installation will be conducted jointly with St. Fabian Council officers at their facility at 32200 Twelve Mile Road in Farmington Hills. A potluck dinner will follow the ceremonies. As always, wives are encouraged to attend the Installation and dinner. More details on the ceremony and the dinner will be announced via an e-mail in the next week or so.
