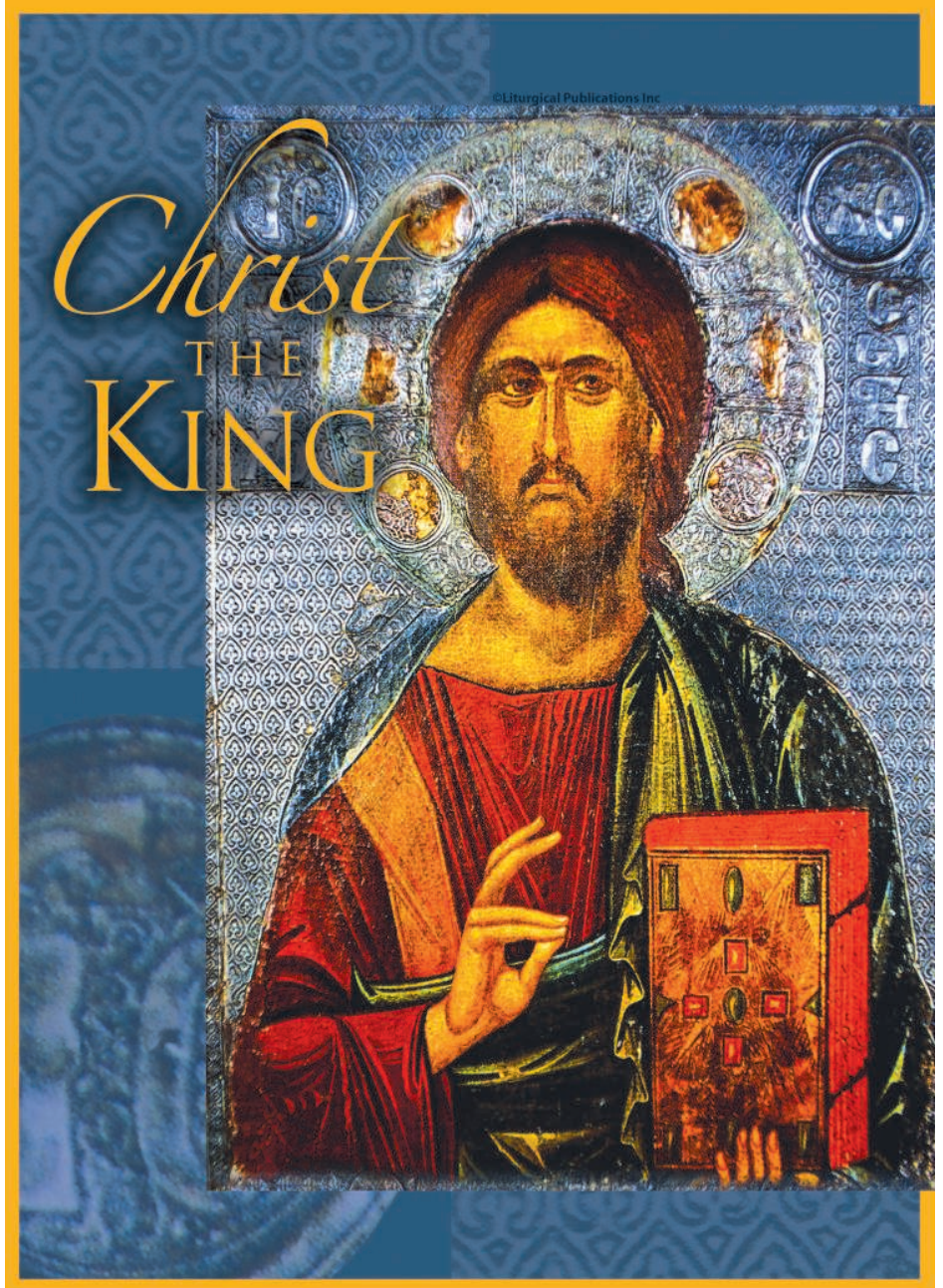

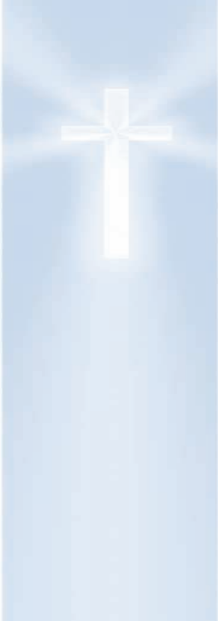

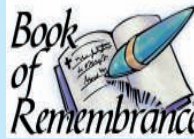

KNIGHTS CORNER

Members Endorse \$1,000 Gift to Parish St. Vincent de Paul to Help Area Families in Need

At last week’s membership meeting, Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr reported that 2018 dues statements soon will be distributed. If you have an e-mail account, your statement will come that way. If you don’t have e-mail, look for your letter carrier to deliver your dues packet. Sending statements electronically results in a tidy savings for the Council. **If you have changed your e-mail address in the last year or so, give Bob a call at 248-888-9335.**



Bob also reported a change in the Michigan Council’s “Take \$5” plus program, a voluntary donation in place since 1977. It has been changed to “\$10 for Charity” to reflect the fact that \$5 doesn’t buy what it did when the program started 40 years ago. Money raised through the program enables the State K of C to assist more than 50 charities throughout Michigan.

Also at the membership meeting, members endorsed the presentation of a \$1,000 check to the parish St. Vincent de Paul Society so it can continue helping families in our area.

A significant event happened in Michigan’s Upper Peninsula last month. The 41st ultra sound machine was dedicated under a Knights of Columbus sponsored program. State K of C officers and leaders of Council 689 in Marquette were on hand at ceremonies at the Care Clinic, a local pregnancy center. Nationwide, more than 750 ultra sound machines are operating as a result of the program whereby the funds raised by a council are matched by the National organization.

This may not be the best time to talk about a wild game dinner being just a few days after Thanksgiving when some say the best meal of the year is enjoyed. A dinner to benefit St. Francis on the Lake, a camp serving adult and children with developmental disabilities, will be held Friday, January 26 at DeCarlos Banquet Center in Warren. The camp and the dinner are sponsored by the Michigan K of C and the Order of the Alhambra. Advance tickets are \$50 each. For information, go to the Michigan K of C website at www.mikof.com.

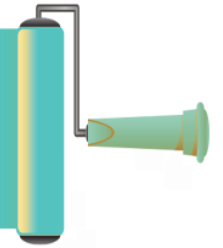
