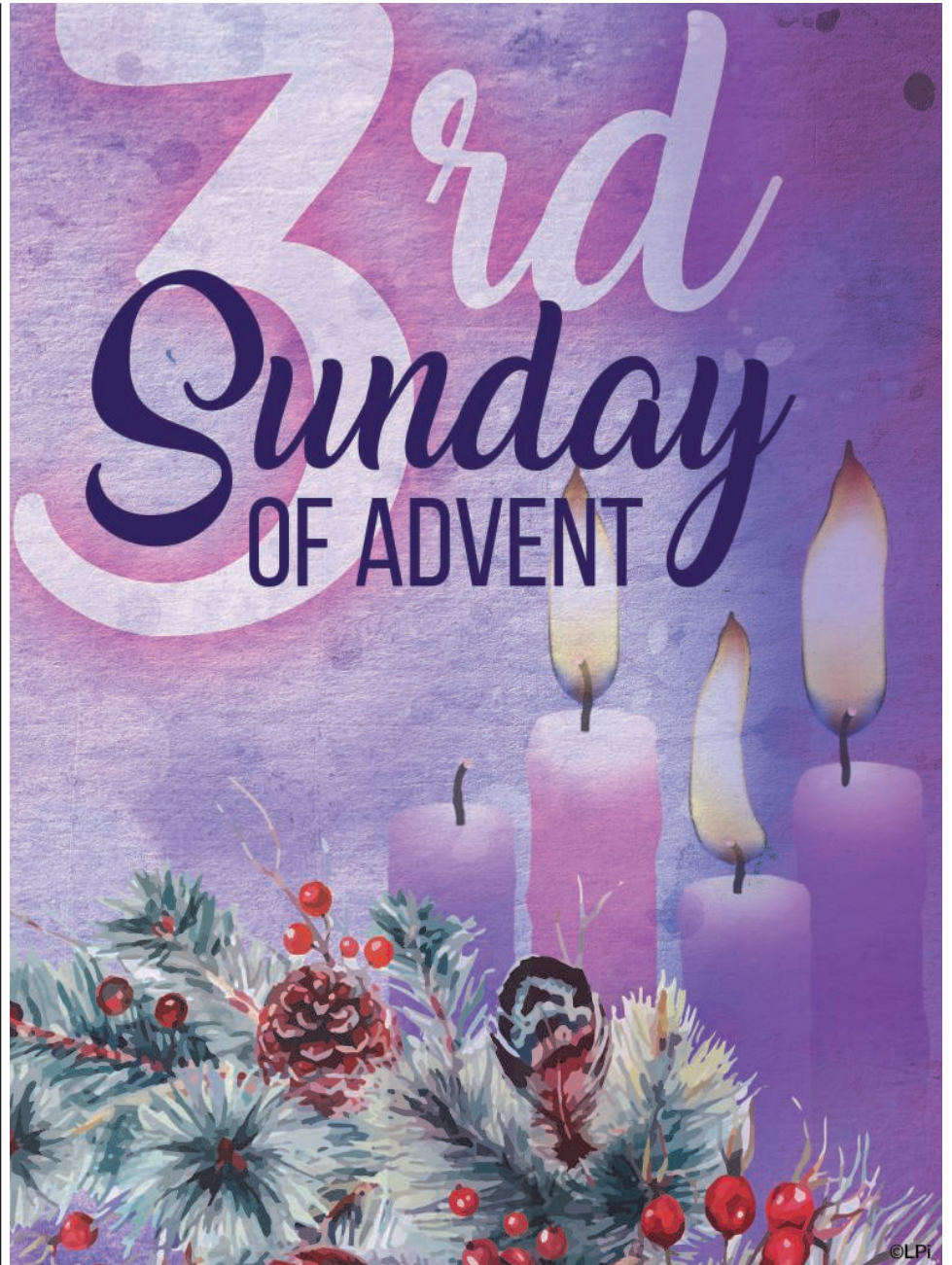

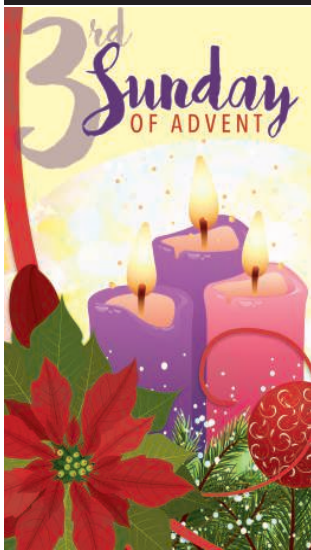

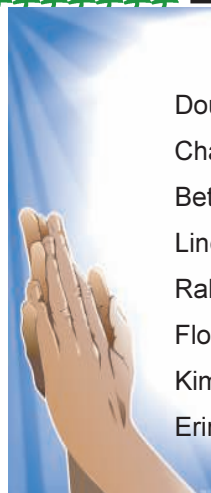

**Millionaire Party Volunteer Duties, Time Requirements Explained at Tuesday's Member Meeting**

Brothers are reminded that they can pay their 2018 dues at Tuesday's Membership Meeting which will open at 7 PM. At this article's deadline, Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr had collected dues from only 14 members. The dues statement has a new wrinkle this year. The long-standing "Take \$5" optional donation, established in 1977 by the State Council, has been upgraded to "\$10 for Charity." Funds collected allow the State Council to help more than 50 charities throughout Michigan, supplementing the state charity raffle.



Included on the agenda is an explanation from Millionaire Party Chair Thom Seabolt of the duties and time commitments required of volunteers for that activity. 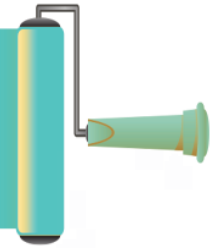

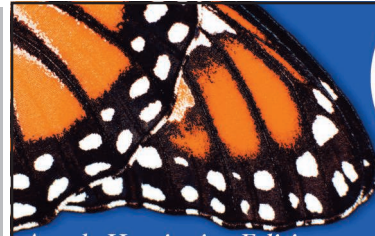
