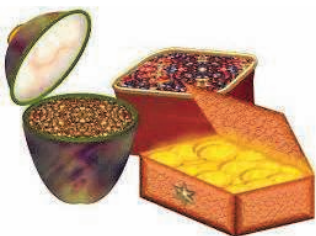

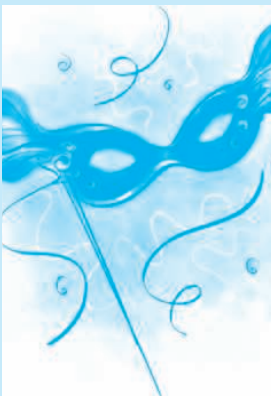

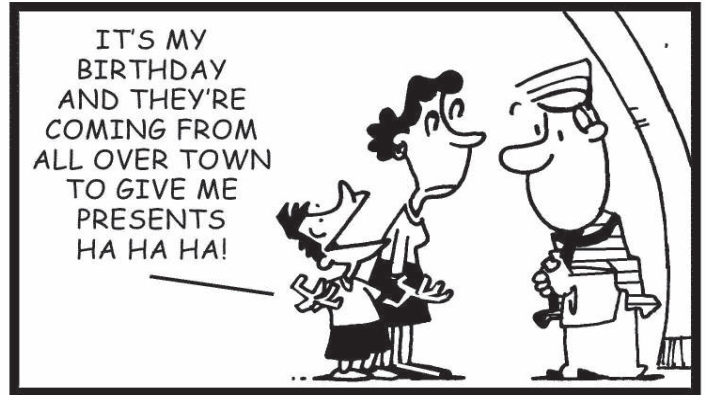

KNIGHTS CORNER

Use Available Worksheet to Compile Charitable Activities for Supreme K of C Report Due January 31

If you haven't received an invoice for your 2018 dues, either through an email or through the U.S. mail, give Financial Secretary Bob Kuhn a call at 248-888-9335. There is a glitch in the records. Chances are that you are missing other important communications from the Council.

Some Council Officers will be attending a semi-annual District Meeting January 22 at St. Fabian. These sessions involve representatives of the six Farmington-Farmington Hills Councils that make up District 12 of the Michigan K of C and are conducted by District Deputy Jim Escott. He keeps the locals up to date on State programs as well as acting as a coach and teacher.

GK Fred Gerometta is compiling a report on the fraternal activities of our Council that the Supreme Council uses to prove its tax-free status to the IRS. To help individual Council members tally up their activities during the past year, a worksheet is available at www.kofc.org/forms. Once on that page, click on Form 1784A. It can be printed. Or contact Program Director Tom McPhail and he will email you a copy that you can print and use. Complete the copy and bring it to the January 16 Membership Meeting. The compiled Council report is due in Supreme headquarters January 31.

A reminder that the Knights will be serving breakfast for the parish from 9 AM to Noon on Sunday, January 28, with net proceeds going to the St. Gerald St. Vincent de Paul Society. That group's operating funds are being really strained at this time of year and can use all the help it can get. Event Manager Dave Bednarski will be circulating a sign-up sheet at the January 16 Membership Meeting. He also is looking for a Knight to train as his successor as pancake boss. As he explains the job, "I make sure we have enough supplies, ask the guys to help and then get out of the way. The guys know what to do."

Ushers, Eucharistic ministers and lecturers are needed by the parish. Ushers are the biggest need, especially in the winter when so many of parishioners head for warmer weather. Ushering adds an extra ten minutes or so to your trip to church. And when a full complement of ushers is in force it is done every third Sunday. 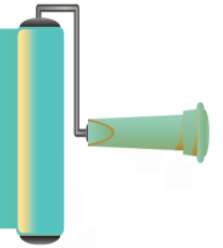

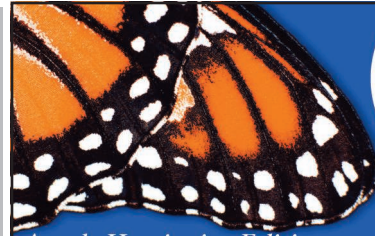
