Net Proceeds of January 28 Pancake Breakfast to Benefit Parish St. Vincent de Paul Society Efforts

Our Council will open the new year with a familiar project – a Pancake Breakfast on January 28 with net proceeds going to the St. Gerald St. Vincent de Paul Society. The recent unusually cold weather has put a strain on the Society’s resources, so the help will be welcomed.

At last weekend’s masses, Vincentian Sherry Kuhr, wife of Council Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr, outlined some of the Society’s activities, while thanking parishioners for their support and generosity. She also reminded mass-goers of the Pancake Breakfast. Preparations for the Pancake Breakfast are underway. At Tuesday’s Membership Meeting, Deputy Grand Knight Dave Bednarski will be circulating a sign-up sheet so workers can report their availability, Dave also is looking for a Knight to train as his replacement as the Event Manager, since he is in line to move up to the Grand Knight spot July 1 under the Council succession program. That program was adopted in 2015.

Dave describes the job of Pancake Boss as an easy one. “I make sure we have enough supplies, ask the guys to help and then get out of the way,” he said. “The guys know what to do.” As our practice, pancakes will be served after the 8:30 and 10:15 masses – 9 AM to Noon. Tickets will be available at the door but, since this is a benefit, free will donations are encouraged.

The Council also will use the event to push sales of State Charity raffle tickets. The raffle offers three great cruises, plus 26 other cash prizes ranging from \$150 to \$2,000. The cruises for two persons include air fare and cash and cover the Mediterranean, Canada, New England, and the Western Caribbean. Fourth prize is a three night stay in Philadelphia with \$500 cash. When you sell a ticket, be sure to put your name and Council 13673 on the stub. The Council earns \$1 for each ticket sold.

If you haven’t paid your 2018 Council dues, Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr will accept your check at the Membership Meeting. Later this month, he will be bothering delinquent members with a second notice.

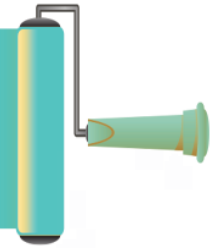
