



### **Operating Comments:**

For the six months ending December 31, 2017, our weekly offertory and holy day collections provided 72% of the total revenue. The \$253,823.00 collected in offertory combined with Christmas collections, bequests and donations and other income enabled us to meet our expenses of \$293,257.00 to end the period with a net operating surplus of \$61,243.00. Our goal for the current fiscal year is to collect offertory in amounts sufficient to cover all operating expenses. This can be accomplished as we pray and share as a parish family.

Salaries and benefits account for 47.1% of expenses. This includes salary, health insurance and retirement benefits for staff and clergy. Staff salaries and benefits are 38.5% of expenses and clergy salary and benefits are 8.6% of expenses. The Archdiocese of Detroit sets compensation for the clergy. Ideally, we would like to be at or below 50% of total expenses.

As you plan for the year ahead, we encourage you to reflect carefully on what you are able to give to support St. Gerald and its' ministries. We also ask you to consider enrolling in the Electronic Giving Program. This helps provide a consistent revenue stream and alleviates declines in the weekly offertory associated with holidays and vacations.

<sup>\*\*</sup> The St. Alexander property was sold for \$500,000.00 cash and after paying all loans, the remaining amounted to \$87,756.00. This amount closely approximated the costs to maintain the property for last two years.

#### **Comments:**

- The Checking Account balance represents cash needed to pay for two months' Operating Expenses.
- General Savings Account is established to provide for future repairs and maintenance as needed.
- The balance in the *Changing Lives Together Fund* represents the amount due on the new lighting system. This project and others, including a new garage storage facility, prayer garden, church carpeting, pew cushions, upgrades to the sound system and new candle holders, were funded by parishioner contributions to the *Changing Lives Together Program*.
- The Sale of St. Alexander Fund is the remainder of the proceeds from the sale of the St. Alexander properties after paying the loans due to the Archdiocese.



### Should We Support State K of C Endowment Fund to Finance Scholarships for Sacred Heart Seminarians?

A contribution to a State K of C Endowment Fund to provide scholarship money to Sacred Heart Major Seminary students will be one of the agenda items when Council Officers meet Tuesday. State Officers established the fund in the latter part of last year at the request of Archbishop Allen Vigneron. The State Board organized the fund under the Michigan Knights of Columbus Charities Inc., the State's 5019c)(3) tax-deductible fund. The State is asking Councils for a contribution of \$6 per member this first year. The goal is a raise \$1 million and maintain it through 2026.

Speaking of contributions, members at the January Membership Meeting approved a \$300 donation to Core Nigeria, the medical mission run by former Pastor Fr. Festus Ejimadu. Brother Paul Borchert and his wife Sue set up that fund. Paul said Fr. Festus reported that 1,100 patients had been seen by the seven doctors hired by the mission. In past years, the high was about 500 patients.


