

Setting up an account will also allow you to set-up payment methods that can be used for future donations. An email address can only be used once per Online Giving URL.

- Step 1 Go to http://stgerald.aodcsa.org
- Step 2 Click on the **Create New Account link** or the **Sign up for a New Account** link.
- Step 3 Fill out information for New User Account First Name, Last Name etc.
- Step 4 When finished filling information out Click Enter Credentials
- Step 5 Create User ID and Password. (If you gave on-line last year, you can use last year's ID and Password)
- Step 6 Click the Create Account button. You will receive email confirmation that your account has been created.

Knights Corner


Triumvirate of Bednarski, Gariepy and Grabinski to Lead Our Council in the Coming Year
