





On this Solemnity of John the Baptist, it is fitting that today's Scripture passages focus on him. The Prophet Isaiah states, The Lord called me from birth, from my mother's womb, he gave me my name. In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles, St. Paul reflects on St. John the Baptist's career, and how in humility, John professed that he is not worthy to unfasten Jesus' sandals. In reference to John, the evangelist St. Luke proclaims, the child grew and became strong in spirit, and he was in the desert until the day of his manifestation to Israel. John the Baptist is called from Elizabeth's womb to be a herald for Christ and to bring a baptism of repentance to his people. Willingly, John accepts this call through great hardship.
