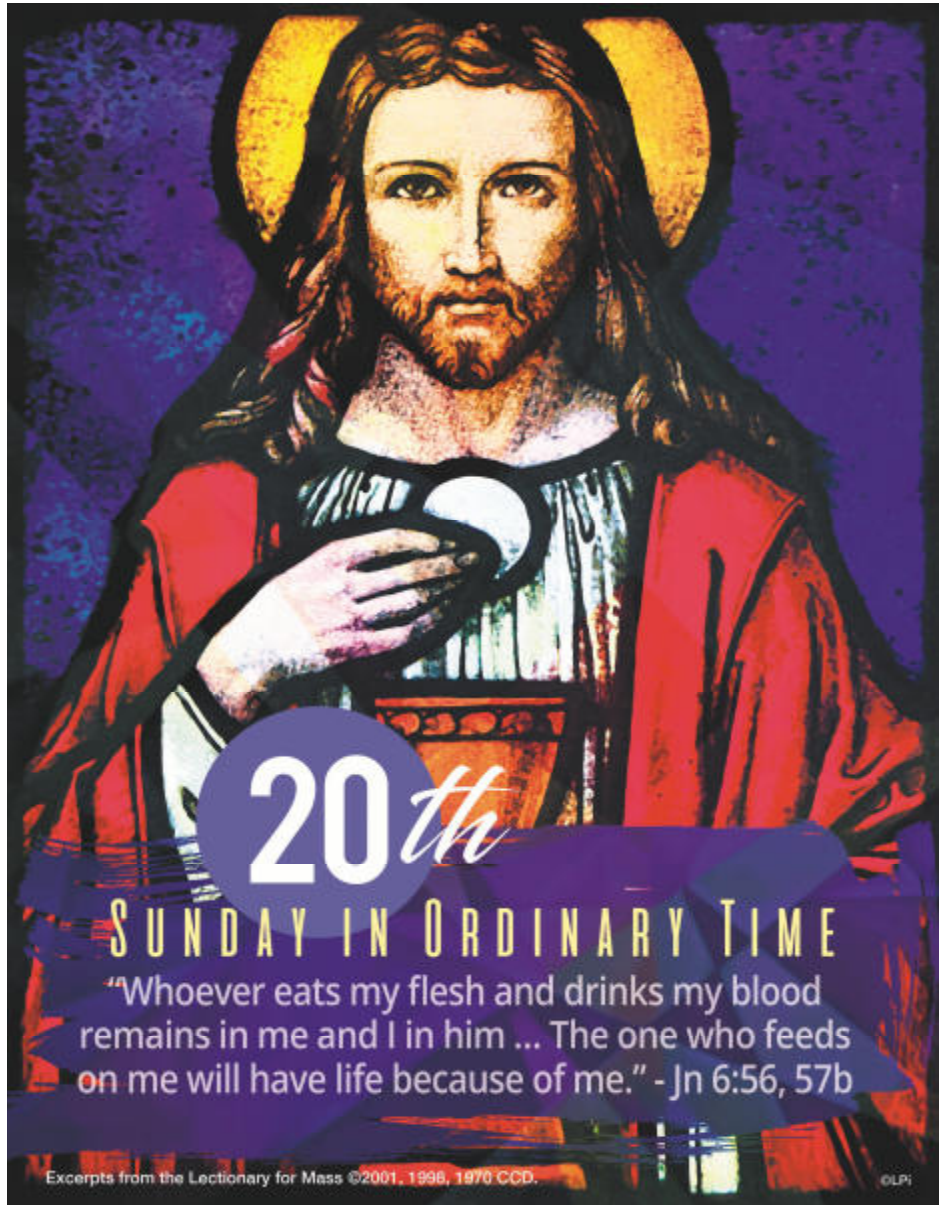

New Online Giving**

Catholic Vantage, our current source of online giving, has informed us that they will no longer offer the E-giver program effective September 30th. We have worked with Simplegive to establish our new donor managed online giving. Visit our website at [www.stgeraldparish.org](http://www.stgeraldparish.org), and on the left-hand side of the screen click on the tab "Online Giving". You will be directed to "Welcome to Online Giving" allowing you to set up your account to manage your donations. Some of the benefits of this new program include:

- Managing your donations anytime. Changes are immediate.
- Credit Cards are accepted, as well as Bank EFT's.
- Donations can be made to Archdiocesan Campaigns (Except CSA).  
*Examples are Peter Pence, Catholic Relief, Catholic Charities, etc.*
- Ability to view giving history at any time.

This new system is convenient for you because you are in charge and can make changes at any time to your online giving. It does not require you to contact your bank to sign up or do anything else. You can use your credit card, debit card, checking or savings accounts and the funds will be automatically transferred to our parish bank account.

If you need help or do not have access to a computer, please contact the Parish Office at 248-477-7470, and we will be glad to assist you.

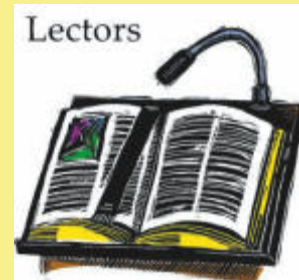

**STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS**

In today's Scripture reading from the Book of Proverbs, Wisdom inspires the people to forgo foolishness and eat the food and drink that God has "mixed." This prefigures St. John's Gospel account where the evangelist further develops Jesus' theology of sacrifice and His institution of the Holy Eucharist — the true source and summit, strength and unity, of Catholic life. What a tremendous gift! St. Paul, in his Letter to the Ephesians, encourages us to discern the will of the Lord, and to give thanks for everything in gratitude to God through Christ. As Christian stewards, we strive for union with the Lord by regularly partaking in Christ's Eucharistic banquet. Strengthened by the reception of Holy Communion, we embrace evangelization as we commit to stewardship as a way of life. We do this when we share His joy and peace with our parish community and those brothers and sisters who are in need of our Lord's message of hope. Besides weekend Mass attendance, try to attend at least one weekday Mass to meet Jesus in the Eucharist.



**Knights Corner**

**Tuesday’s Membership Meet to Ask “What to do with Profits from September 23 Pancake Breakfast?”**

The coming week will be a busy one with the monthly Membership Meeting Tuesday and a major service project Wednesday, when three Knights and their spouses cook dinner for clients of the South Oakland Shelter. Program Director Tom and Arlene McPhail, PGK Fred and Diane Gerometta and PGK Bruce and Diane Roberts will be cooking for 40 to 50 people at the South Oakland Shelter on August 22 at North Congregational Church in Farmington Hills. This is the fourth year our Council has cooked dinner at SOS.

One of the major agenda items will be deciding what should be done with the net proceeds from the September 23 pancake breakfast. Last September’s breakfast produced a donation of \$4,000 to the National K of C Disaster Relief Fund to aid victims of Hurricanes Harvey and Irma. Proceeds from other breakfasts have gone to our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society efforts.

Also on the agenda is the presentation of a citation as August Knight of the Month to Bob Koenig and a citation as August Family of the Month to Fernando and Julissa Guerra. They are being honored for their service to the Council and to the Parish.

There still are spots available for the All Knights Retreat sponsored by the Michigan K of C Council at St. Paul of the Cross retreat house December 7-9. The weekend begins with dinner on Friday and ends with a Sunday morning mass. The suggested donation for the weekend is \$215 and covers two nights lodging and five meals. If you have old eye glasses, sunglasses or rosaries cluttering a dresser drawer, bring them to church and place them in the box in the social hall marked “Eyeglass donations” or give to an usher. Trustee Bill Croitori will see that the item will be reused. The glasses often are sent to former Pastor Fr. Festus’ Project Nigeria. The broken rosaries are repaired and given away, often locally when Bill and wife Joanne pass them out to unprepared wake goers.

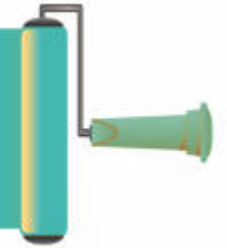
