

In the framework of the reading from the Letter to the Hebrews: ... for whom and through whom all things exist through God, today's Scripture readings from the Book of Genesis and St. Mark's Gospel promote the common theme of sacred marriage. Knights Corner Supreme Council Awarded \$712,000 in Scholarships Last Year; Apps Being Taken for 2019-2020 Academic Year

Some 450 college students received a helping hand from the Knights of Columbus during the 2017-2018 academic year, splitting \$712,000 in scholarships. Most recipients were children of Knights or Knights themselves attending Catholic Universities or Catholic Colleges in the United States, Canada, Mexico, Puerto Rico or the Philippines. Those figures include \$278,750 in awards given to 113 seminarians in the United States and Canada. Applications for scholarships for the 2019-2020 academic year are now being accepted. Or write Dept. of Scholarships, Knights of Columbus, 1 Columbus Plaza, P.O. Box 1670, New Haven, CT 06507. In some cases, grandchildren of Knights are eligible for awards.
