

Knights Corner

Members OK \$1,000 Gift to St. Vincent de Paul for Thanksgiving, Christmas Distribution to Needy Families

A big Welcome to Michael Huskey who is our newest member. He took his First Degree October 17 at Our Lady of Sorrows and was sponsored by Financial Secretary Bob Kuhr. We look forward to getting to know Michael.

Thanks to the Knights who responded to a request from Fr. Kris and ushered at last Sunday's Noon Mass when 17 of the parish young people were confirmed by Bishop Donald Hanchon. Looking sharp in their red Council shirts were PGK Bruce Roberts, Deputy Grand Knight Frank Gariepy, Bob Purol, Jack Davis, Treasurer Rich Rosowski and Program Director Tom McPhail. Brother Paul Borchert also helped, serving as one of the Eucharistic Ministers.

At the Membership Meeting October 16, members unanimously approved donating \$1,000 in the form of gift cards to the Parish St. Vincent de Paul Thanksgiving and Christmas food program. It is a donation that the Council has been doing nearly every year since our formation in 2005. Donating time and money is one of the principles of our Order.

Last year Knights throughout the world – there are nearly 2 million men in our brotherhood – gave more time and funds than ever before. Charitable contributions surged to more than \$185 million. They also contributed more than 75.6 million volunteer hours. "The cumulative hours are impressive," Supreme Knight Carl Anderson said. "But more impressive is the fact that these works were done by individual Knights in their local communities – works done by men who are true Knights of Charity: who are everyday heroes."

Michigan Knights again were among the leaders in charitable giving and time. They donated \$6.4 million, fifth best, and worked 2.4 million hours, good for ninth best. Texas led both categories with \$9.8 million and 4.6 million volunteer hours. In 2017, our Council provided 3,114 volunteer hours and made \$6,746 in charitable donations.

While on the subject of volunteers, a few are needed for the St. Gerald Food Drive November 10-11 in the Alta Loma neighborhood. That is the area west of the Farmington City Hall and Library. If you can help from 10 AM to 3 PM on Saturday passing out donation bags and from 10 AM to 1 PM Sunday collecting food, give Project Coordinator Shatomi Kerbawy a call at 248-434-7561. Even if you can work only an hour it will help, so call.
