





Setting up an account will also allow you to set-up payment methods that can be used for future donations. An email address can only be used once per Online Giving URL.

Step 1 Go to http://stgerald.aodcsa.org

Step 2 Click on the Create New Account link or sign in with last year's information.

Step 3 Fill out information for New User Account – First Name, Last Name, etc.

Step 4 When finished filling information out Click Enter Credentials

Step 5 Create User ID and Password. (If you gave on-line last year, you can use last year's ID and Password)

Step 6 Click the Create Account button. You will receive email confirmation that your account has been created.
