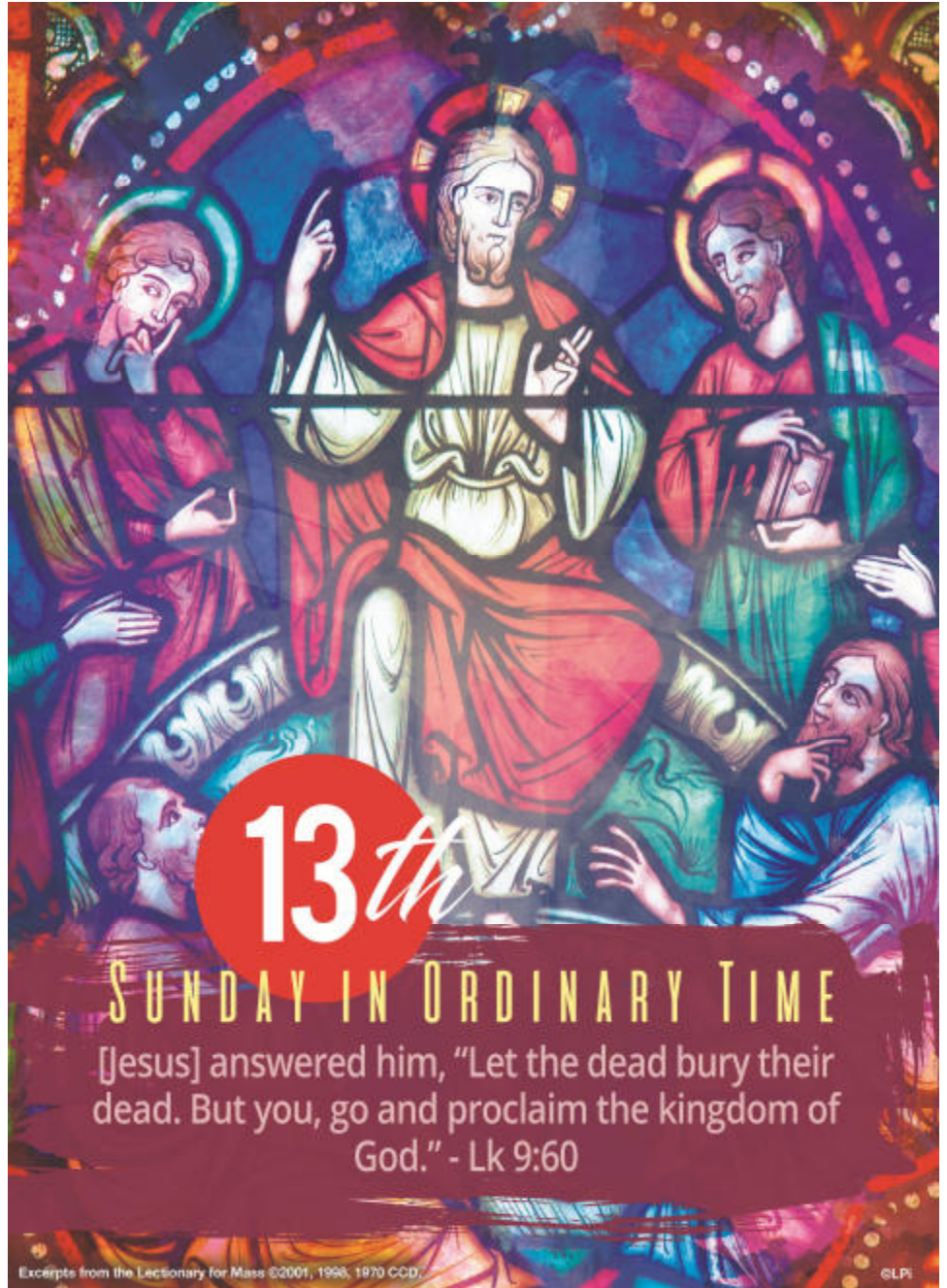

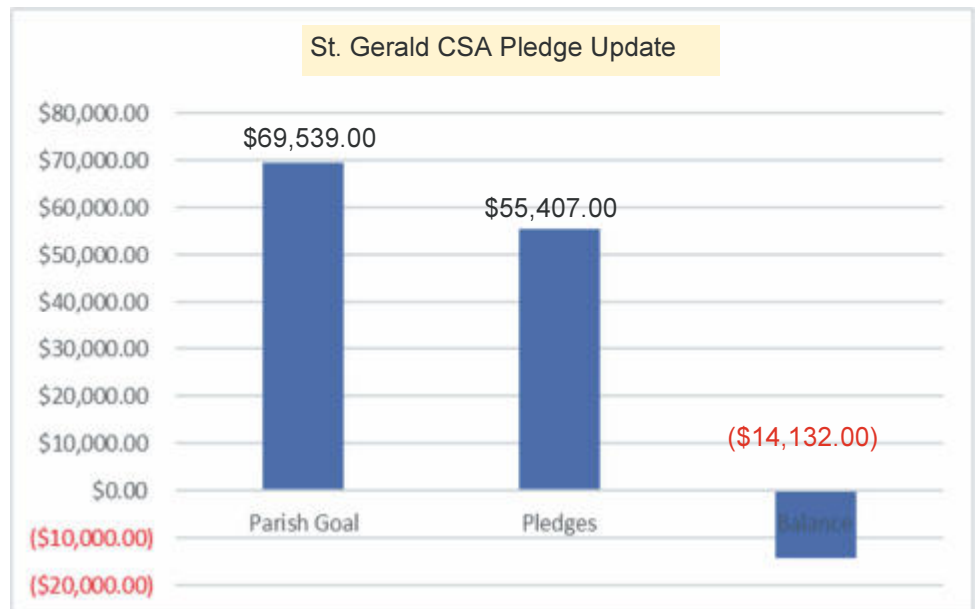

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Some conversion stories people tell are so profound and meaningful that they make you want to invent a story for yourself. Some of us have these type of stories to tell, but most of us can only tell stories of slowly coming into a greater maturity of faith over many years and many mistakes. I personally was baptized as an infant, grew up in the Church, and never experienced a time when I was fully the prodigal son. I have sinned quite often throughout my years, but I never drifted so far away where I needed that moment of truth to help me see the light.

However, that does not diminish the fact that I have been made new in Christ and I need to live in a way that leaves the old me behind. If you are like me, you must admit there are times when that former self comes into view. There are times when we fall into our sin to the point where no one would believe we were baptized disciples of Jesus. Thank God there is forgiveness through the sacraments. When we fall, we can always recover and be made new again.

So maybe it is not true that people like me don't have a profound conversion story. Maybe the truth is we simply have MANY conversion stories. As we continually strive to pick up our crosses and follow Him, we fall away and need to come back to Him. Each time, we have a new story. Each time, God's love and healing are profound. Each time, we have something new to tell.

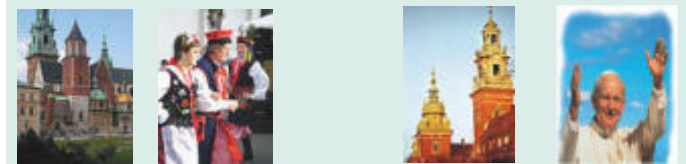

He also organizes and directs our annual Corn Toss tournaments at the parish picnic and serves as a one-man retention committee that deals with members dropping out of our Council. Frank also authors the frequent e-mail news blasts to the membership.

The Rosowski's are long time parish activists. They both are ushers at the 8:30 AM Sunday Mass and Candy also is a Lector. Rich's other duties are he serves on the Parish Finance Committee. He is the Council Treasurer and the developer of our annual budget. He also has been a mainstay of the crew that sets up the tents and tables for the parish picnic and the main ticket seller at our pancake breakfasts.

As Treasurer, Rich writes the Council checks, the latest one being for \$911 and representing the net proceeds from the June 8 Casino bus trip. Members approved donating it to the Supreme K of C Council's American Wheelchair Mission. The goal of this initiative is to provide aid to those who lack the freedom of mobility in local communities and throughout the world, bringing independence and dignity to recipients. The donation was one of a series of steps to qualify the Council for a Star Council award.

July will mark the start of a new fraternal year and the beginning of new terms for our officers. GK Dave Bednarski reappointed PGK Rich Smith as Membership Director and Tom McPhail as Program Director. Under the Council's succession policy DGK Gariepy will be in line to step up to Grand Knight, creating a need to find a new Pancake Breakfast coordinator. As Gariepy describes it "the job requires buying the supplies and then getting out of the way. The guys know what to do and they do it very well." 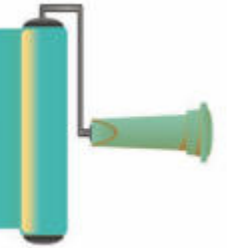
